A collaborative classroom is one where students and educators work together and share responsibility for class projects. With PBwiki, you can supplement your active learning techniques in the classroom and easily create a collaborative online classroom presence – without involving the IT department!



Use PBWiki to Build It

A PBwiki is an easy to set up webpage that encourages classroom cooperation and team building. With PBwiki you can quickly create a home page and build unique pages for each project.

How do I get started?

- ▶ A great first step is to upload or post your syllabus and lesson plans. You can simply copy your word document and paste it into the front page of your wiki.
- ▶ Invite your students to view your syllabus using our Share tool
- ▶ Create a new page featuring a list of discussion questions from today's class. Ask your students to post responses to discussion questions and add their own ideas.

PBwiki lets you create a free educational wiki in 30 seconds. (A wiki is a web page that multiple people can edit.) Use PBwiki to create your own safe online space where you and your students build a shared space to exchange files, collaborate on group projects, and share knowledge.
